CLINICAL PRECEPTORSHIP MEETING

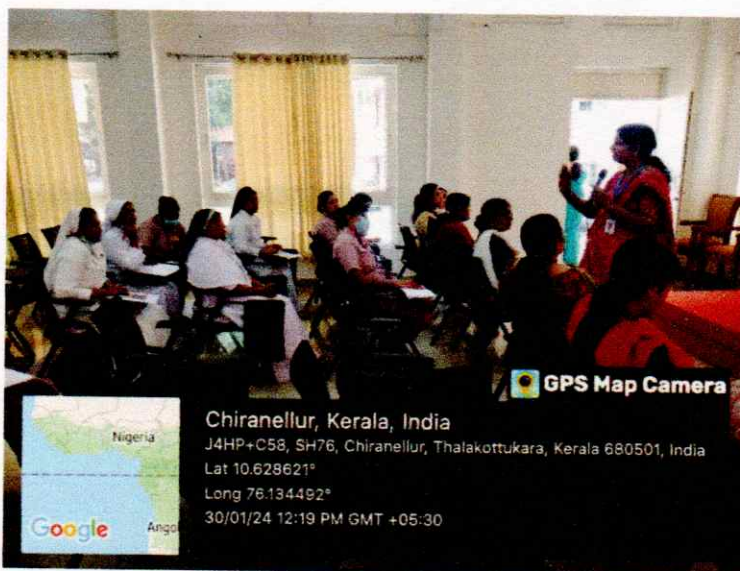

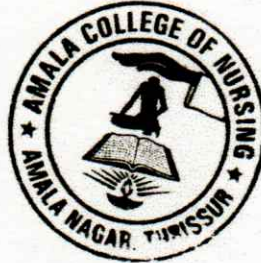
