Course fee will be collected by Ajinorah in the following manner





7. It shall be the duty and responsibility of the candidates to appear for OET examination conducted by International agency and clearing examination. Whereas, Ajinorah can assist in exam registration.
8. Once the candidates clear the examination, Ajinorah will assist for their documentation and recruitment process for overseas placements. As part of the training process, candidate need to write CBT exam, for the which training will be provided by Ajinorah and its associates/firms will help the students to get a better placement in the UK and other countries.

- 4.2 Clause 4.1 shall not apply to any information which has come into the public domain.


