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









MINUTES OF CURRICULUM COMMITTEE MEETING ON 14-12-2023

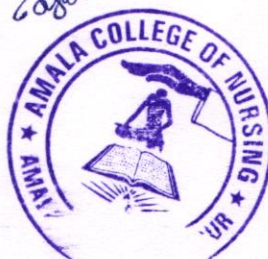
With the blessings of God Almighty the curriculum committee meeting was held on 14th December 2023 at 9.30am at Amala Boulevard, college of nursing.

Agenda Discussion

1. Curriculum Preparation and Updates
