### Flash Mob:

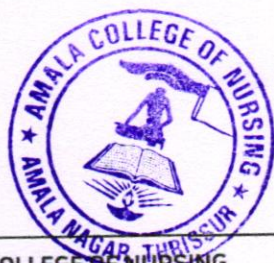
