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## REPORT OF CURRICULUM FEEDBACK

Feedback on curriculum implemented at Amala College of Nursing for the 2023 batch and analysed in the month of June 2024.

The major findings on analysis are

### **Curriculum feedback by students**

#### **2023 batch- 1<sup>st</sup> Semester**

**Applied anatomy:** most students are satisfied with all aspects of the curriculum, though some have indicated disagreement.

**Psychology:** while almost all students are satisfied with all aspects of the curriculum, some students have marked a neutral and disagreement.

**Applied physiology:** The majority of students agreed with the variables of the syllabus assessment.

**Sociology:** Majority of students were satisfied with curriculum implementation while 60% showed disagreement with the variables of curriculum assessment.

**FON:** Majority of students were in agreement that the subject is related to core curriculum, adequate availability of reference material and syllabus has good balance between theory and application. 4% pointed out the lack of reference materials.

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### **Curriculum feedback- Teachers**

Majority of teachers expressed agreement with the syllabus. Some teachers expressed concerns in balance between theory and application

### **Curriculum feedback-Employer**

The overall job performance of students of Amala College of Nursing as staff nurses were rated good. According to the evaluation, they performed well in patient care.

### **Feedback on nursing students by other professional**

The overall rating given on performance of nursing students by other professionals was good. 4 evaluators pointed a need to improve professional values, approachable and involvement in patient care.

### **Curriculum feedback-Alumni**

12% of the alumni was seldom satisfied with clinical exposure and clinical guidance provided in the institution.

The major issues identified on evaluation of curriculum feedback were:

- ❖ Lack of relation of subject to the core curriculum of the programme
- ❖ Lack of adequate reference material
- ❖ Lack of balance between theory and application
- ❖ Lack of adequate exposure in clinical area

The above issues will be discussed in curriculum committee meeting for taking remedial action plan.
