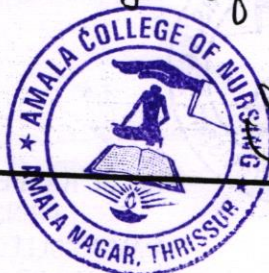

(6) Participants

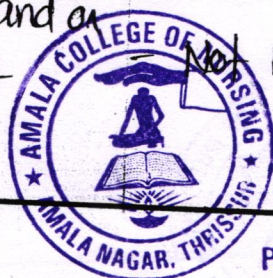
- In this study eligibility criteria and the sources and methods of selection of participants are explained clearly.

- Not mentioned clearly



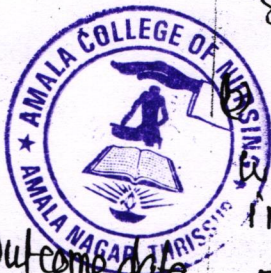

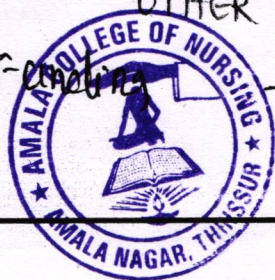
