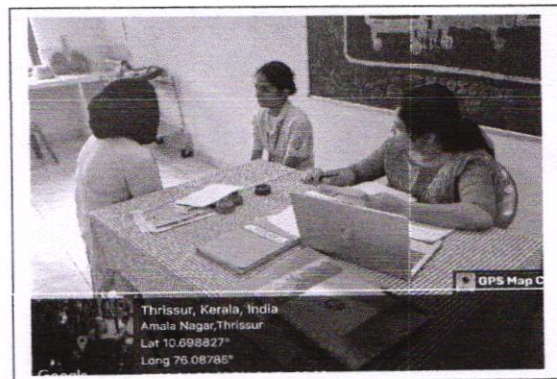
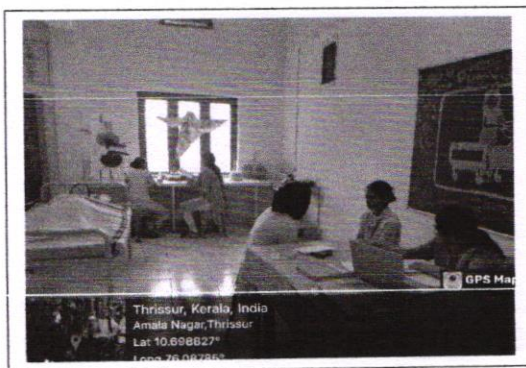
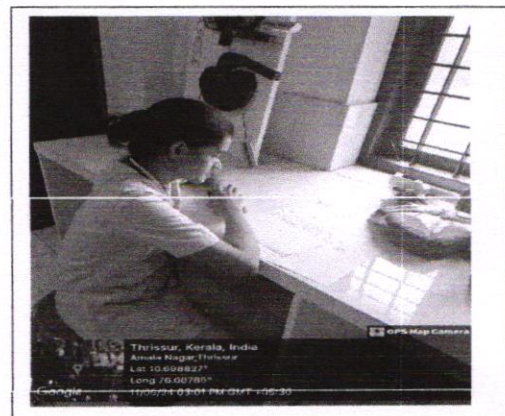
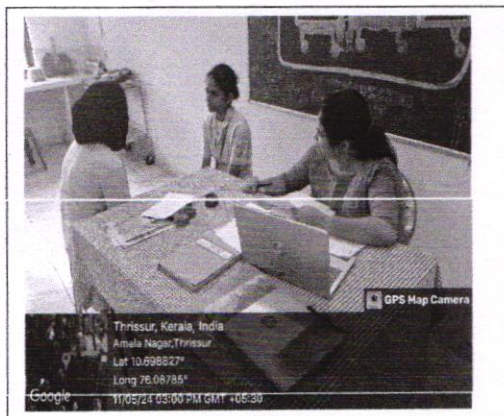






**DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH NURSING

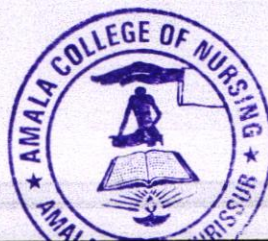
## Symptoms and Diagnosis

A physical exam and throat culture or rapid strep test can confirm the diagnosis and identify the underlying cause.

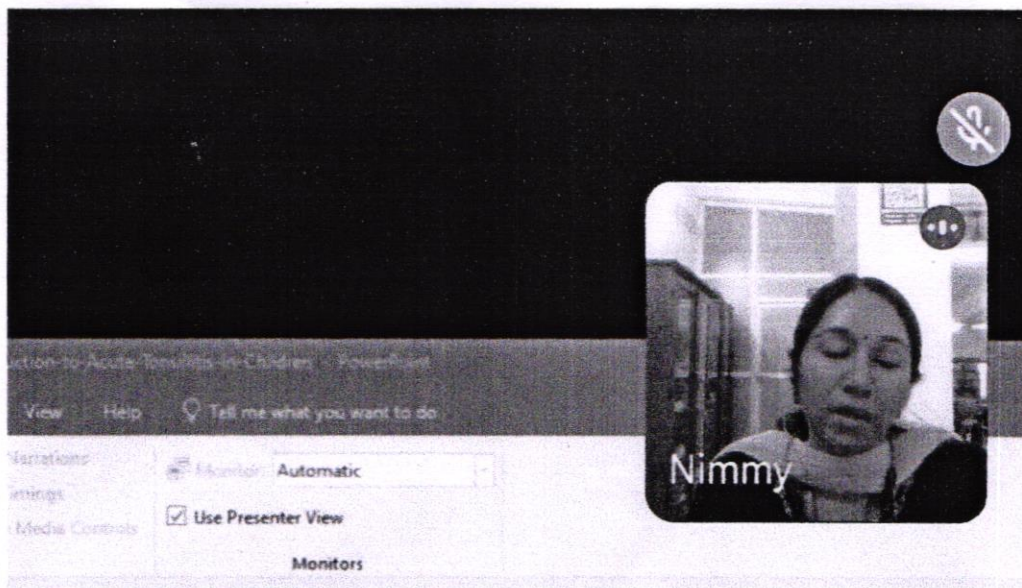

## Non-pharmacological Nursing Interventions

- 1 **Hydration**  
Encourage the child to drink plenty of warm fluids to soothe the throat and prevent dehydration.
- 2 **Rest**  
Advise the child to get plenty of rest to allow the body to fight the infection.
- 3 **Soft Diet**  
Recommend a soft, easy-to-swallow diet to minimize discomfort and promote healing.

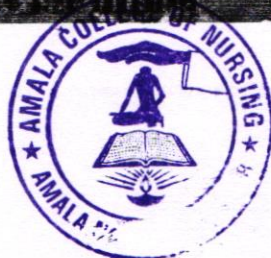
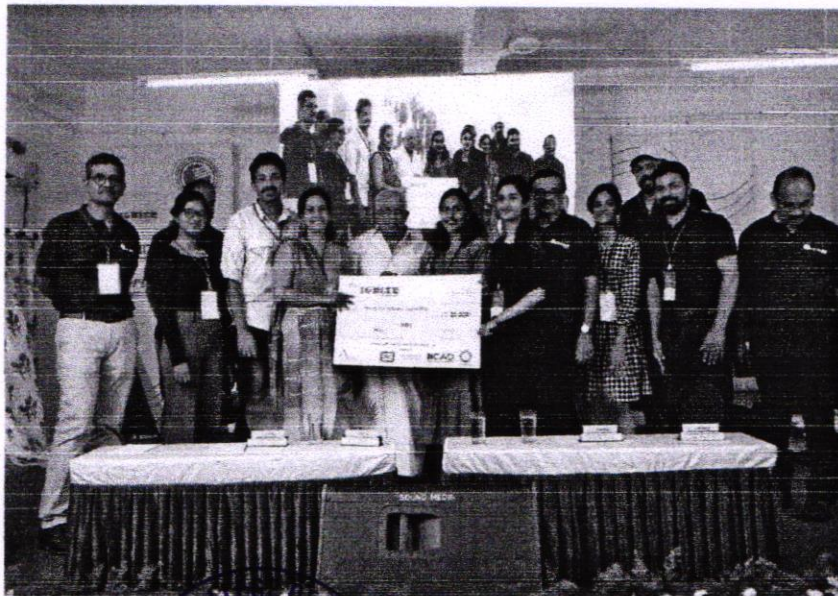
## REPORT ON DARSANA IGNITE 2023

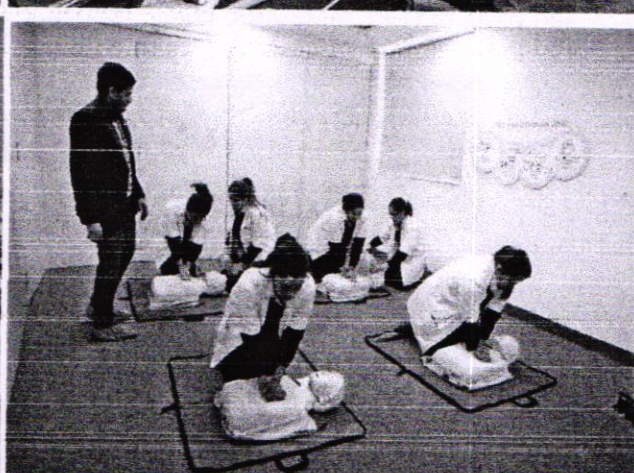
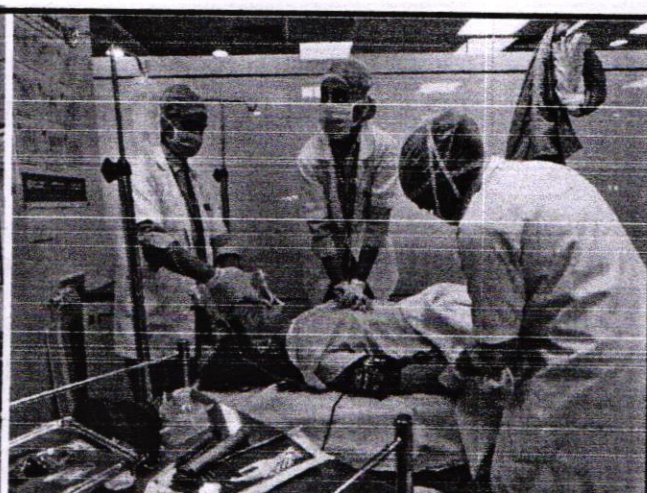

Indeed, it was a proud moment for Amala college of Nursing for carving its name in a new branch. A world of innovation.

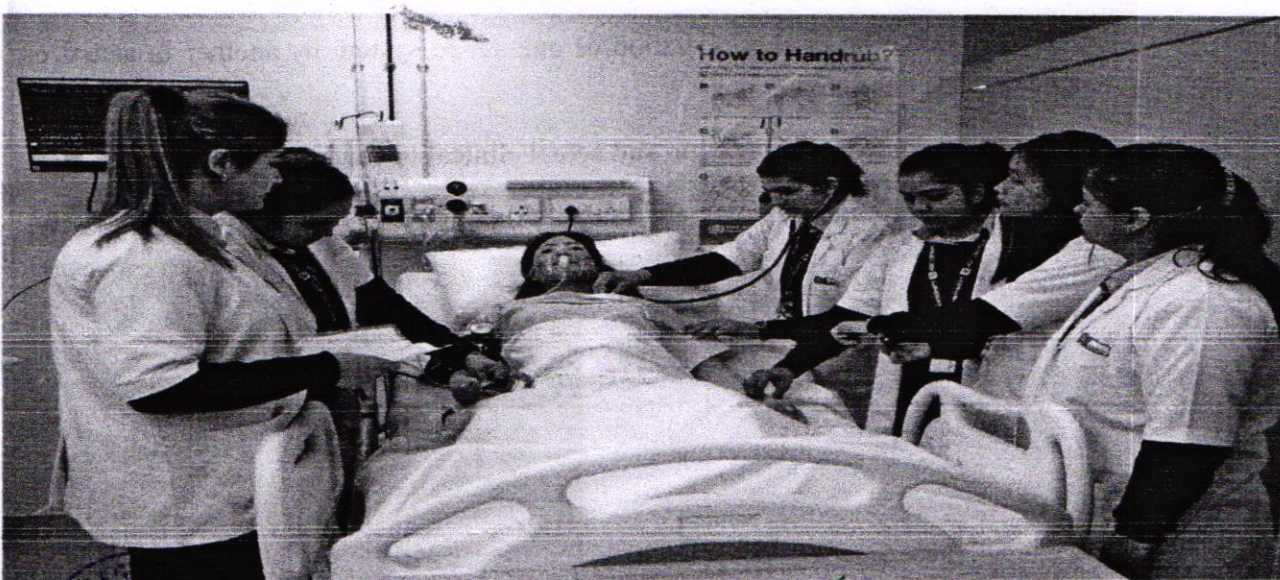




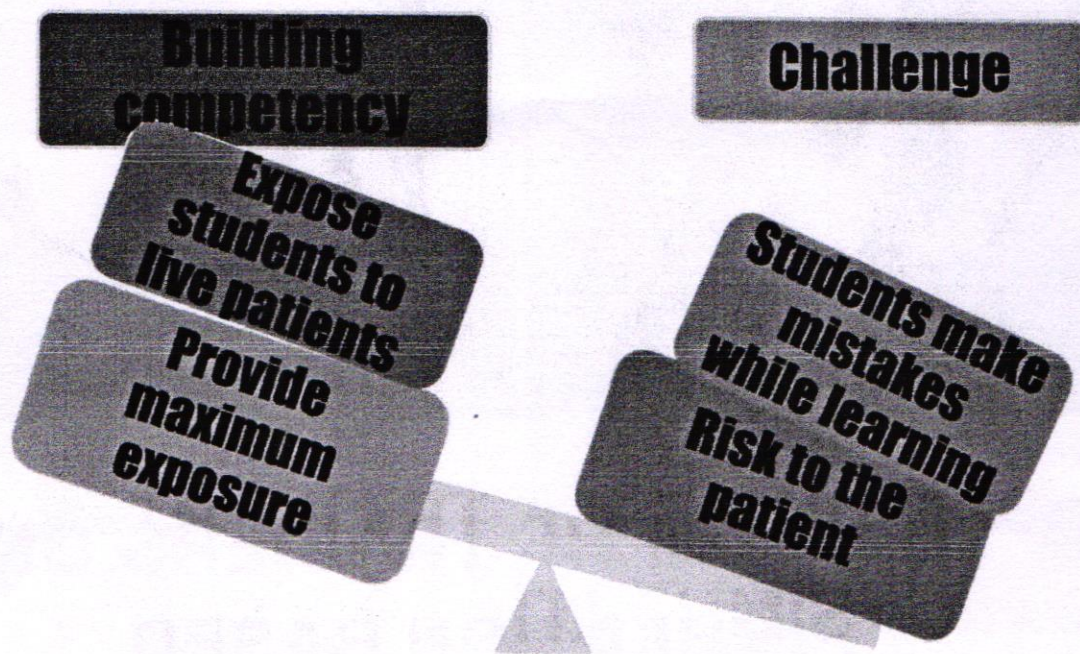

# TRAINING OF TRAINERS ON SIMULATION BASED TRAINING

## National Reference Simulation Centre (NRSC) :

The NRSC was established in October 2018 by Tetra Partite collaboration between Indian Nursing Council (INC), Jhpiego, Laerdal and SGT University with the vision of implementing inter-professional education in the State of the Art simulation centre through simulation based education. It has been developed to support the clinical parts of all the 4 years of B.Sc Nursing curriculum- Nursing Foundation, Medical Surging I and II, Child Health Nursing, OBG Nursing and parts of the Community Health Nursing.



## Simulation Based Education:
