Detailed Report on Students Benefited Due to Exposure to Laboratories

Amala College of nursing has 8 highly advanced and equipped laboratories named as follows,

In each year the college is ensuring that all students are adequately exploring and utilizing each laboratory as per the recommendations given by the respective regulatory bodies. Prior to the clinical postings, examinations, OSCE and several other modules are conducted by every batch in respective academic years


In first year, students are allotted for the per-clinical practical and demonstration of several nursing procedures that helps them for the clinical experience and bedside nursing care. The nutrition lab is utilized by the students for conducting the nutrition practicals. During the second year of the course all students are benefit from the skill lab, advanced nursing lab, simulation lab and community lab as a part of curriculum. In each lab they are able to carry out the practicals of several procedures in the syllabus.

During third year, students are exposed to the child health lab, computer lab as a part of research practicals and advanced nursing skill lab for the practicals. In fourth year, students get the detailed exposure through the OBG lab, community lab and AV aid lab for the curricular and co-curricular activities.

Along with this, OSCE is another platform where the students are utilizing laboratories in the college of nursing, The simulation lab is also provides adequate exposure for the students to experience the clinical set up in certain situations, especially during pandemic and all.

As per the new semester system in nursing course, the final semester practical examination are conducted with direct observing evaluation as well as OSCE in the College of Nursing. Hence the students are highly familiar with the lab facilities and opportunities.
