### Foundation Lab

- Foundation lab is equipped with all sophisticated equipment and advanced manikins for gaining extraordinary skills to the students.
- The lab is well furnished and well ventilated with all the necessary equipment like patient beds, mattresses, bed sheets, bedside locker, linens and blankets, napkins and towels, bed cradle, cardiac table, wheel chair, stretcher, critical care unit (with O2 cylinder with flow meter, CPR dummy and Suction apparatus), different sizes procedure trays, and other instruments.
- And all the equipment are as per INC recognize and enough for each nursing courses.

### Child Health Nursing lab

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- The lab is equipped with various manikins, models, & charts related to child development and other informations develop hands on skills under the continuous guidance& supervision.
- It also includes baby manikins to practice pediatric nursing procedures, growth charts, and immunization schedules and play materials for different age groups.

#### **Community Health Nursing lab**

- This lab ensures the students to learn home visiting bag technique & practice the community health nursing.
- The lab is equipped with variety of audio visual material to practice health teaching in primary care for individuals, families and groups at both urban & rural settings.

#### **OBG lab**

- This lab is designed to help the learner to reinforce the learning about normal physiology of pregnancy, midwifery, obstetrics
- The lab is equipped with various manikins, models, & charts related to antenatal, intranatal and postnatal care to develop hands on skills under the continuous guidance& supervision.

#### **Nutrition lab**

- This lab is designed to assist the students to acquire wide range of knowledge of dietetics in Indian settings & to understand the concepts of” Nutrition, Health & Disease” while planning the diet for individuals and groups in the hospital and in the community.
- The lab is equipped with all the facilities like gas stove and electrical stove, cookers, sinks fridge, freezer, variety of articles and vessels for the development of skills to assess the nutritional needs and to prepare different menus for various disease conditions.
- This well-ventilated lab has the capacity to accommodate 30- 50 students for their interactive training in nutrition.

### **Computer Lab**

- College of Nursing is equipped with a well maintained computer lab along with 50 nos computers and its accessories for the better productive learning of the upcoming nurse.
- Lab provides Computers with access to electronic medical databases, online libraries, e-books, journals, and clinical resources such as **UpToDate**, **PubMed**, and **Nursing Reference Center**.
- Provides opportunity for the students to get familiar with Software for health record management (e.g., **Electronic Health Records (EHR)** systems), simulation programs for patient care, and virtual clinical environments for training.

### **Simulation Lab**

- Amala simulation skill lab was established in the year 2021, inculcate evidence based simulation competence into Nursing curriculum
