ACTION TAKEN REPORT OF ANTISEXUAL HARASSMENT CELL 2023- 2024

The Internal complaint committee for the academic year 2023-2024 was constituted with the Principal, Prof. Dr. Rajee Reghunath, as the Chairperson. The committee members included Prof. Sr. Jyothish, Adv. Phinergeev Alappatt V, Mrs. Rosariyo Anto, Mrs. Aswathy Gopi, Mrs. Gladis George C, Mrs. Nimmi P. G., Mrs. Rinu David (PhD Scholar), Miss Ayana Baby (UG Student), and Mrs. Sheena John (PG Student).

A meeting of the Internal complaint Committee was held on 25th January 2024, at 3:00 PM in the Conference Hall of Amala College of Nursing. The agenda focused on addressing complaints related to sexual harassment among students and staff. It was noted that no complaints were received during this period.

The committee resolved to organize programs to raise awareness among employees and students on the prevention of sexual harassment in the workplace. As part of these initiatives, posters emphasizing the prevention of sexual harassment were displayed across the college premises. Adv.
