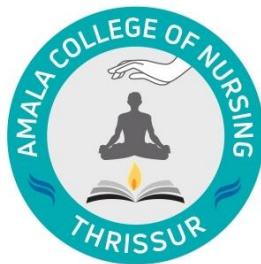

SENSOR BASED ENERGY CONSERVATION

LED bulb with day and night sensors has been installed in the first and third floor of the college building. The system has a high quality light sensor in it, which switches 'ON' the plugged bulb at evening when the light intensity is less than 30 Lux and switches 'OFF' the plugged bulb in the morning when the light intensity is more than 70 Lux.

A sensor based water dispenser has been installed near to the reception. This reduces water wastage.
